Lastly, MAKE SURE YOUR STUDENT HAS TWO PAIRS OF SHOES to use at band camp. It is highly likely that they will get wet - and no one wants to march in wet shoes and get blisters - it is the leading

preventable cause of trips to the nurse! Shoes may NOT be flip-flops - they must at a minimum have a strap on the heel. Also, if your student is like mine, they have spent way more time online than getting out and moving. Marching is hard work and will test their stamina...they need to be outside, walking at least a mile regularly. (They will likely be marching and playing way more than that!).
